COMMUNITY SERVICES

- Officers conducted an 'Avoid the 13' DUI check point on Bridgeway, resulting in two arrests.


TRAFFIC MONITORING

MONTHLY CASE SUMMARY

- A victim in a bar fight received serious facial injuries. Two suspects were arrested
- Officers investigated a felony assault between sisters. During an argument, one sister struck the other over the head with a ceramic bowl.
- Officers investigated a rape that occurred in San Francisco but reported here.
- A resident reported two suspicious persons in the area of Cloudview Road. Officers contacted the subjects and discovered both had a history of theft and drug arrests.
- Officers responded to the area of Easterby in regards to an argument and possible gunshots being fired. It was determined to be a heated argument between a store clerk and an upset patron who was knocking over display racks. There was no merit to a firearm being discharged.
- Officers investigated a 'road rage' incident between a motorist and a bicyclist. The motorist attempted to use his vehicle to force a group of bicyclists onto the sidewalk. There were no reported injuries.
- During this month, police investigated 8 residential burglaries, 6 burglaries from vehicles and 5 commercial burglaries.
- A couple performed a 'dine-and-dash' to avoid paying a \$500 dinner bill.
