Committee question to Ms. Griffin:

 Why would you like us to remove the Condition requiring a replacement tree be planted?

Ms. Griffin responded that the majority of the tree will be removed, but a small off-shoot would remain and she would like to work with the spur so that it grows into a full size, healthy tree.

Committee question to staff:

 What is staff's recommendation for a replacement tree? Staff responded their standard condition is the tree shall be replaced with a 24-inch box of a desirable tree species to be determined by the property owner.

Removal of Condition of Approval:

 The small spur is to remain, and the Condition for a replacement tree is removed.

Vice Chair Reich moved and Committee Member Liddell seconded a motion to approve a Tree Removal Permit for 47 Girard Avenue subject to the removal of the Conditions of Approval. The motion passed 3-0.

2. TRP 12-151, Tree Removal Permit, Casa Madrona, 801 Bridgeway. Tree Removal Permit to allow the removal of one Cottonwood tree located in the courtyard area of the Casa Madrona Hotel and Spa at 801 Bridgeway (APN 065-063-46).

- Committee Member Liddell suggested that the replacement tree be either a Japanese Maple or Wild Lilac.

• The replacement tree shall either be a Japanese Maple or Wild Lilac, and the timing for the replacement tree is to be changed from 60 days to one year.

Committee Member Liddell moved and Vice Chair Reich seconded a motion to approve a Tree Removal Permit for 801 Bridgeway subject to the modification of the Conditions of Approval. The motion passed 3-0.
