

You are invited to attend a City Council public hearing on the following project:

PROJECT: Appeal of a Planning Commission decision (Resolution No. 2013-30, adopted on November 6, 2013) to deny a Design Review Permit and a Non-Conformity Permit to reconstruct a historic fishing pier for use as a shore-based recreational fishing and passive waterfront access for ambulatory and mobility-impaired persons at a non-addressed parcel to the immediate south of the Trident restaurant in the 500 Block of Bridgeway (APN 065-172-03). The project consists of replacing decking, railing and pilings in the approximate same location as the existing pier. The applicant is the City of Sausalito and appellant is Jonathon Goldman on behalf of the City of Sausalito Department of Public Works.
