

How to Download eBooks and Audiobooks to a Kindle Fire, Nook Color/HD, Tablet Computer, or Android Mobile Device Using the MARINet OverDrive Collection

Sausalito residents have access to the MARINet OverDrive collection, consisting of over 10,000 ebooks and audiobooks that can be downloaded to a Kindle Fire, Nook Color or HD, tablet computer, or other Android mobile device using a special app. The books are hosted on the OverDrive platform. **Follow the steps below to download a title.** If you have any trouble at any step of the way, please call the Reference Desk at 289-4121 or City Librarian Abbot Chambers at 289-4123.



Go to your device's app store (e.g. the Google Play Store or the Amazon Appstore) and search for OverDrive. Tap to go to the OverDrive Media Console download page.

Touch the **Download** or **Install** button at the top of the OverDrive page and follow the prompts. The app is free.

When the download completes, touch **Open** to launch the OverDrive Media Console. For future visits, just launch OverDrive from your collection of apps.

When you launch the OverDrive the first time, you will be prompted to either sign up for a new OverDrive account or sign in with an existing account. If you are signing up for the first time, choose the "Sign in using library card" option (orange button). After searching for and selecting Sausalito as your library, input your library card number and password to log in.

Touch the small **≡** button in the top left of the screen.

Touch the "Add a Library" link. A window will open up and show an Add a Library search box. Enter "94965" into the box and touch the **Search** button. Select the link that says "**Sausalito Public Library.**" Now touch **MARINet** to see titles available to Sausalito and Marin County residents.

You should now see a web page featuring the MARINet Digital Downloads collection.

Now log into your account by clicking the "**Sign In**" link in the gray bar at the top of the page. Select Sausalito from the Select Library pull-down menu. Enter your library card barcode number and PIN and click the **Sign In** button. If you don't remember your PIN, please call the library (289-4121) during open hours to reset your PIN.

The simplest way to browse the collections of e-book and MP3 audiobook titles is to **click the large **≡** button below the MARINet OverDrive logo** and then use the navigation menu in the brown bar near the top of the screen to view either fiction or nonfiction titles. Touch the **View more...** link to see more categories. You can also choose the **All Fiction** or **All Nonfiction** to see everything available, regardless of category.

If at any time you want to return to the **Home** screen, just touch the MARINet Digital Downloads logo

When you are browsing book covers, a grayed out book or headphone icon mean that e-book or MP3 is checked out and not available. A black book or headphone item means that the title is available.

If you are looking at all titles and you come across a book that is checked out, you may place a hold on it by touching the book cover and then touching the **Place a Hold** button. You will be notified via email when it is available.

When you find an available title that you would like to check out, touch the book cover and then touch the green **Borrow** button. You should now see a **Go to Bookshelf** button. Click the button.

From the Bookshelf page, touch the green **Download** button. If you are downloading an e-book, select EPUB eBook and then touch the **Confirm and add to app** link below EPUB (there are no secondary prompts for MP3 audiobooks). If you have an Amazon account, you also have the option of downloading the Kindle version and reading the book with the Kindle app, but this is a more complex process.

A spinning wheel will appear while your book is downloading. Please note that MP3 audiobook titles will take much longer to download than e-book titles.

To access the title you have downloaded, touch the small  icon in the top left of your screen. Now touch the menu item that says Bookshelf. You should now see the book you just checked out.

Touch the cover icon to start reading or listening to the title. If you have more than one title in your collection, they will appear in a stacked list. Each title will also show the format (e-book or audiobook) and the number of days you have left before your checkout expires.

E-book and MP3 titles may be returned early by touching a book cover and holding your finger down. Then touch the **Return** button.

Touch "Add a Title" or the small  icon (and then the MARINet link) from within your bookshelf to browse for more books.
