Chili Cook-Off Policies DAY OF

- Welcome to the 30th annual chili cook off. You can begin setting up your area. We wish you all good luck and a great day! A map has been provided for with your space number. You may park in the Dunphy Parking lot, off of Napa Street. **Please check in at the ticket booth before you set up.**
- Cooking must start by 8am.
- All chili must be prepared on site. Items may not be prepared in advance. Beans may have been soaked the night before.
- Chili must be ready for tasting by 12 Noon.
- You must prepare 10 gallons of chili.
- You must bring all your own materials, supplies, pots, utensils, tables and cooking apparatus.
- Tasting cups and spoons will be provided by Park and Recreation Staff at check in and throughout the day as needed.
- No electricity is available on site.

Special Notes

- ❖ ***As the day progresses and the urge to pour more and more tequila into your chili, please remember to not serve it until the alcohol content has cooked off. There will be persons under 21 tasting your chili.***
- ❖ ***Please bring a bowl of your chili to the judges area no later than 12:00 Noon.***
- ❖ ***A small canvas chili bag has been provided for you to keep all your “people’s choice beans”. Please keep this bag until a Parks and Recreation Staff person picks it up for tabulation. As you solicit beans, they should all be kept in this bag.***

Awards!

Awards will be handed out in three categories:

People Choice: 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Judges Choice: 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Best Ambience

Criteria include costumes, presentation and decorations. Please remember this is a family event, so use good judgment.
