- 3. Approval of Minutes *None.*
- 4. Review and Approve Housing Constraints Section: Staff will add the following to paragraph 4.2.3: Underground and seasonal springs/creeks can limit the accessibility to available land. Chris Visher will provide input to staff regarding building cost listed in paragraph 4.2.4.

Public Comment: Land in the Marinship is subsiding at the rate of 1 foot per 10 years.

Vice-Chair Cox moved and Commissioner Bair seconded a motion to approve the housing constraints section as modified. The motion passed unanimously

- 5. **HEC Schedule/Subcommittee Discussion**. The committee welcomed Kim Stoddard who owns property in San Jose and has worked in Sausalito as a realtor.
 - a. Discussion of HEC Schedule and June 8, 2010 City Council discussion. Chair Pfeifer and Vice-Chair Cox provided an update to the City Council on June 8, 2010. Chair Pfeifer will be updating the City Council at each meeting regarding HEC progress. Chair Pfeifer and Vice-Chair Cox will provide a further report to the City Council on the HEC calendar at its July 27, 2010 meeting.
 - b. Discussion of Subcommittee Roles.

Second dwelling units can be in multi-family as well as single-family dwelling units, i.e., a single family home on an R2 lot. There are a lot of nonconforming units, i.e., duplexes that are actually triplexes. Staff has access to lots of helpful data, i.e., FAR, parking, building coverage, etc. Steve Flahive requests staff provide him with a current list of businesses being taxed as a source of data for identifying second dwelling units. Sausalito contracts with "Municipal Services" to administer the City's business tax.

6. Second Dwelling Unit Questionnaire: Staff circulated and requested feedback on a second dwelling unit questionnaire. Not all illegal units built since 1984 have been counted, probably because not counted by the census. The committee discussed the possibility of an amnesty program for 2nd units.

Public Comment: PG&E or garbage collection agency has information from meters. Perhaps a cross check of survey data against meter data could be performed. In certain areas, second units were prohibited because of parking constraints. This needs to be addressed in the housing element.

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Vice-Chair Cox moved and Steve Flahive seconded a motion to approve the second dwelling unit questionnaire. The motion passed unanimously

2. Public Comment on Items Not on Agenda- None

3. Approval of Minutes – July 12, 2010 and August 9, 2010

Vice-Chair Cox moved and Chris Visher seconded a motion to approve the minutes as amended.

The motion passed unanimously.

4. Subcommittee Reports

- a. Liveaboards (Cox): Chair Pfeifer and Vice Chair Cox met with Bob Batha of BCDC. The 10% liveaboard cap is fairly firm absent exceptional circumstances. BCDC is willing to make certain other accommodations, however, including permitting a contract with a "honey boat" instead of requiring sewer hookups at each pier. Chair Pfeifer and Vice Chair Cox will visit various marina owners to update them on the information learned from BCDC. Any housing element will need to include provision for liveaboard parking, which is presently constrained.
- b. **Accessory Dwelling Units** (Schinsing): The City will be prepared to share a report at the next meeting on September 13, 2010.
- c. Vacant Land (Kiernat): Resident Kiernat will not make a report for her subcommittee this evening; she prefers to wait until she has an opportunity to meet with her other team member, Councilmember Mike Kelly.
- d. Underdeveloped Parcels/Multi-Unit Parcel Opportunities (Stoddard): The questionnaire has been finalized with input from Chair Pfeifer and is ready for production and mailing. Resident Stoddard suggests perhaps doing a press release before sending the survey. Joel Paul will assist. Various members of the HEC committee will assist staff in folding surveys and stuffing envelopes in an effort to get the survey mailed to residents promptly.

Public Comment: (1) Boats are on public trust tidelands. Many of the boats do not appear to qualify as affordable housing units. (2) Lots of boats would fall within affordable housing.

- 5. Review Draft Evaluation of 1995 Housing Element: Staff circulated and requested feedback on a draft evaluation of the 1995 Housing Element. Chair Pfeifer and Vice-Chair Cox have substantial comments. Kim Stoddard moved and Joel Paul seconded a motion to appoint a subcommittee consisting of Joan Cox and Chris Visher to review and edit the draft. Committee member feedback to staff is due by August 30. Cox and Visher will meet with City staff to incorporate feedback.
- 6. Scheduling First Public Workshop. Joel Paul will draft an informative notice that will (1) explain the housing element requirement and our process; (2) contain statistics; (3) review



options with a request for input, and (4) share our goals of meeting the housing requirement within an appropriate scale. The first public workshop will be held on October 16, 2010 at 9 a.m.
