#### Discussion

At the January 10, 2011 HEC meeting the Committee decided to schedule the first public workshop for a Saturday in late February (possibly February 19 or 26). Staff is asking for direction of the following:

- · Draft agenda; and
- Notice and outreach strategy.

## Meeting Goals and Draft Agenda

Staff has drafted a meeting agenda for the HEC's review (see Attachment 1). Staff is requesting that the Committee review and revise the agenda as appropriate and take action on the agenda. Staff will forward the HEC's approved agenda to the City Council for their review and concurrence the February 1, 2011 City Council meeting.

#### Notice and Outreach Strategy

There are a variety of methods that Staff could use to provide notice and information to the community regarding a public workshop:

- Publish a notice or flyer in the local newspapers (Marinscope/Marin Independent Journal)
- Publish a notice In-the-Loop
- Post flyers at City Hall
- Post a notice on the City's website
- Create and distribute a press-release packet for distribution to community groups (e.g., Woman's Club, Rotary, Lion's Club, Sausalito Environmental Action, Friends of Dunphy Park, etc.) and the local newspapers (*Marinscope/Marin Independent Journal*)
- Send letter to those on the Housing Element update email/mailing list

Staff has drafted a notice for the HEC's review (see Attachment 2).

Staff has contacted the *Marinscope* regarding the options for running a notice. Staff provided the paper with the workshop notice and was given the following information:

- A 3"x6" ad with the text and the City's logo (no other graphics) would cost \$396;
- A 3"x8" ad with the text and all graphics would cost \$528;
- An insert (which would be the flyer itself, printed by the City and inserted into each of the papers) would cost \$200.
