- Officers continue to monitor the taxi stand downtown and insure that all the cabs have the proper permits and documentation.

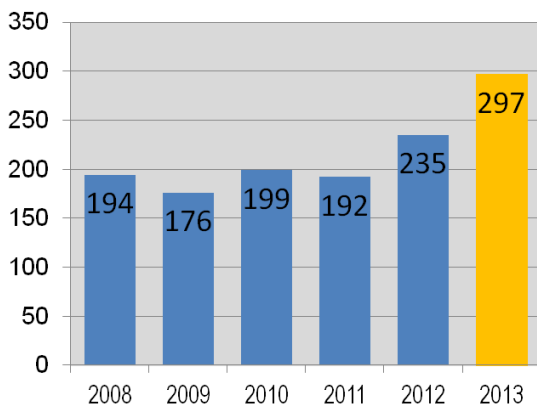
TRAFFIC MONITORING

MONTHLY CASE SUMMARY

- After an argument between upstairs and downstairs neighbors, one subject decided to throw a chair onto the other subject's vehicle causing damage.
- A stolen vehicle was located on Coloma St. This vehicle was stolen earlier in the month from the Sheriff's department jurisdiction. The vehicle was abandoned and no arrests were made.
- A bicycle was stolen out of an unlocked shed fronting a residence on San Carlos Ave.
- Officers arrested several intoxicated subjects in a downtown restaurant who were being unruly and aggressive towards staff. One subject was arrested for assaulting staff as well. All subjects were males in their 50's.
- A juvenile subject stole tip jar money, approximately \$400, on two occasions. On the second occasion the juvenile was caught and arrested.
- Officers contacted numerous juveniles during a party at a residence. Alcohol was located at the party and the homeowners were cited for violation of the social host ordinance.
