  - New focus will be on construction waste
  - ZWM website update to launch soon

    - multifamily housing could be targeted
    - Jazz By The Bay could have better signage and an announcement for Zero Waste
    - The Conservation Corps could be hired to educate & sort
    - Create lots of visuals for tourists
