







Accomplishments

- Sworn staff was increased to 19 positions
- A part-time motorcycle officer was hired to address community traffic concerns
- The SPD passed ordinances to reduce the impacts of tour bus operations and downtown bicycle parking
- The Tracy Way Pilot Project was successful in addressing bicycle parking concerns
- Sausalito's police boat conducted 197 hours of patrols
- The SPD investigated two homicide cases
