




# City of Sausalito's 38th Annual Chili Cook Off

## Participant Information & Registration



- ⇒ Check in opens on Sept. 24th at 7:00 am. Once you check in you will receive your booth number and a staff member will direct you to your 10X10 booth space so you can begin set up. Check in closes at 8:00 am, please plan on arriving before check in closes.
- ⇒ **All chili must be cooked that morning at the park.** Ingredients may be prepared prior to the cook-off and be put together at the event. Beans may be presoaked, onions chopped, garlic pressed, etc. but **NO COOKING.**
- ⇒ Tasting will begin at 12:00 PM SHARP and **NOT** before. Please plan accordingly and start cooking in time to have your chili ready to taste at noon.
- ⇒ 1st, 2nd & 3rd places are awarded in two different categories:
  - Judges Choice:** A panel of elite judges will be tasting and judging your chili. Chili for the Judges' tasting will be collected at 1:00pm.
  - Peoples Choice:** All participants will purchase a bracelet and in doing so will receive "voting tokens". They will use these to vote for their favorite chili.
- ⇒ One booth will also receive the **Best Booth Award.** This award goes to the booth with the best decorations, set-up, costumes, and ambiance in keeping with this year's theme **Wild Wild West.** This will be decided by a secret mystery judge.
- ⇒ **You must cook a minimum of 10 gallons of your famous chili.** Although we do recommend 15 gallons. Judging will end for People's Choice once a booth runs out of chili, or at 2:30, whichever comes first. (The secret is to fill the tasting cups halfway - that will help the chili to last longer.)
- ⇒ Contestants will bring their own materials, supplies, pots, stoves, utensils, tables, and cooking apparatus. **There is no electricity available for a heat source.**
- ⇒ Each team registered by **(AUGUST 26)** will receive two free 2015 Chili Cook Off aprons (with their booth name printed on it) and two Chili Cook Off participant ribbons.
- ⇒ Please remember this is a family event and use good taste in displays and attire.
- ⇒ You will be provided Tasting cups and spoons by the City of Sausalito.
